Construction Update

Meghan gave us a construction update and a walking tour of the Johnson Creek Blvd work site. SCC is largely done with the storm water utility work. They are presently working on the foundation for the catenary poles and the three types of retaining walls for the project.

In November, SCC will begin "pulling rail," which is installing the 800 ft long segments of rail that will be pulled into place from the welding staging areas at Main St., Powell St., and Fuller Rd. Park & Ride areas.
